#### 1. Call to order

#### 2. Approval of Minutes

#### 3. Introduction of new members and directory update.

#### **4. Old Business**

##### **A. Career Cruising-Appendix A**

Career exploration software for 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade students will continue during the 2010-2011 school year. A staff member must be able to dedicate their time to work with the students while utilizing the software. A list of current schools using Career Cruising software was distributed.

##### **B. Statewide Articulation**

SCC started to submit courses that come through our office for statewide articulation. Once the course is statewide approved, a blue "S" will be displayed next to the course to signal its' approval on the SCC website under articulation. A list of current statewide approved courses was distributed.

##### **C. Completed workshops sponsored by State Center Consortium**

###### ***a. Apprenticeship Workshop (March 11, 2010)-Evaluation***

20 high-school instructors and 200 students attended this one day informational workshop on local apprentice programs and its' benefits. SCC board members are encouraged to view the demographics and student and teacher comments on the evaluation. Partner's can view the video on-line at the SCC website.

###### ***b. Food Safety Certification (March 23, 2010)-Evaluation***

A one day seminar hosted by SCC; 21 Culinary Arts & Home Economics instructors from local high-schools received accredited training on food safety education. Instructors were able to take the Certified Protection Food Manager exam at the end of the day.

###### ***c. CTE Joint Advisory Meeting at Reedley College (March 24, 2010)***

Debbie Marvin-Deeter of ValleyROP reported the following: over 200 college, high-school and business partners attended Joint Advisory Dinner event sponsored by SCC. Partners were able to share ideas and thoughts pertinent to their teaching. Robert Kepford of State Center Consortium presented on the articulation process. A local business partner was honored.

###### ***d. Career Skills Challenge (March 25, 2010)***

SCC sponsored this event with over 700 students in attendance. Students were able to compete in 38 different competitions throughout the day. Partners are encouraged to submit new ideas and new events for next year's challenge.

###### ***e. Online Learning Symposium: A National, State & Local Perspective (April 13, 2010)-Evaluation***

In collaboration with CTAP and FCOE, SCC supported a workshop for teachers providing them with information on how to offer their course(s) online. Over 50 instructors participated in the event. Partners were encouraged to view the workshop online at [ols2010.statecenter.com](http://ols2010.statecenter.com).

- f. Fresno ROP Annual Advisory Committee Night (April 29, 2010)-Evaluation*  
Annual event sponsored by SCC that had over 500 ROP and business partners. Attendees gathered to review/update curriculum and solicit input from advisors to validate ROP courses. Several business partners were honored.
- g. Fresno Chambers' Career Day (May 1, 2010)*  
In conjunction with the Mayor's office and the Greater Chamber Office of Fresno, *The Mayor's Youth Job Fair* targeted students/adults (16-24 years old). Doug Betts reported there were over 900 students/adults at the event obtaining job information from potential employers. SCC encourages its' partners to offer their assistance at next year's event.
- h. Junior Achievement Bank of America Business Challenge (May 17, 2010)*  
SCC partnered with Junior Achievement this school year. SCC hosted ten local high-schools at this entrepreneurial driven event. Scholarships were awarded to the top three finishers.

**D. Job Shadowing-openings available, last day to submit is June 30, 2011.**

An opportunity provided to teachers who haven't been out into the job industry to learn new and innovative techniques pertaining to their teachings. SCC offers 2-day or 5-day job shadowing opportunities to its partners. Two forms are available; the white form is for the current school year and is due June 30, 2010.
