## 1. Call to Order

The Meeting was called to order by SCC Director Amanda Hopkins at 7:33a.m.

## 2. Approval of Minutes

Amanda asked for an approval of the minutes from the September 22, 2010 meeting. Jeff Moore motioned to approve the minutes, Ofelia DeYoung seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

## 4. Old Business

### A. Review and Evaluations of Workshops:

- a. “a-g workshop” was cancelled and tentatively rescheduled for Wednesday, January 12, 2011.
- b. Evaluations for the following completed workshops were distributed: Career Cruising (9.30.10), Infusing Math into CTE, two workshops one in Fresno and one in Ontario, CA (10.13.10 and 10.14.10), Google Tools for the Classroom (10.14.10), Eye on Career Job Shadowing (10.27.10), CTE Distribution Points in Bakersfield, CA (10.28.10) and Building a Website with Weebly (11.10.10). SCC sponsored a staff development workshop for Clovis Unified CTE on 10.14.2010.

## 5. New Business

- A. Due to an overwhelming response to the Google Tools in the Classroom workshop, we have added another date for that training. February 3, 2011 at FCOE we will again offer the Google workshop. - C. CTE Teach, Shelley Powell. CTE teach is a program for brand new CTE teachers based on “*The Effective Teacher*” by Harry Wong. Shelley works with five criminal justice teachers from the South Valley. Her role is one of a coach and a teacher to the new teachers. CTE Teach has 20 sites in California and has given SCC additional money to fund next year and an additional grant to expand the program. SCC will look at referrals from administrators to fill those spots in the late spring/early summer and will be focusing on the college level. It is a two year time commitment from the teachers and administrators.
- D. Madera Fossil Center, this new museum open in Madera offers standards based programs for students and teachers. Please visit when you get an opportunity.
- E. Natalie Culver-Dockins, Dean of Workforce Development Fresno City College, informed the committee that there is a new Health Sciences IT federal grant available. FCC is one of ten colleges in California that has the grant to train 300 people for two different roles over the next
