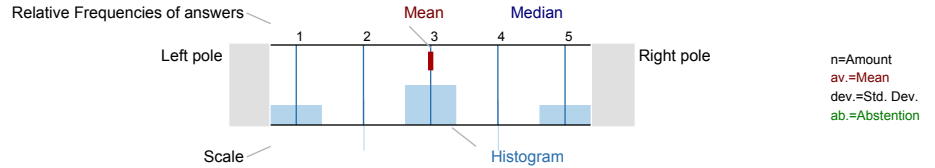

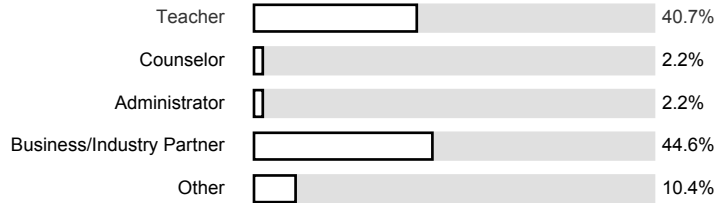

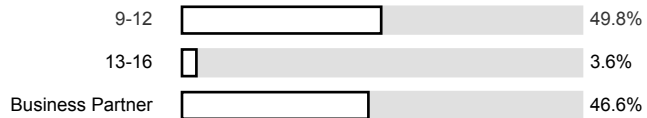

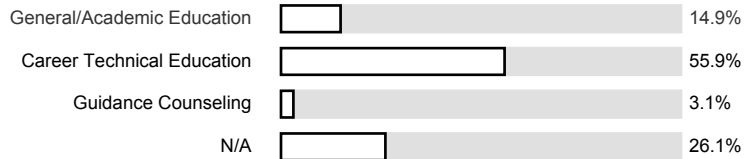
1.1) Which best describes your position? n=231



1.2) Which best describes your primary responsibility? n=221

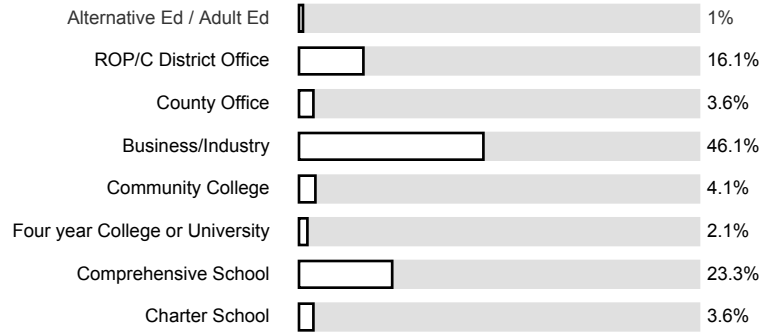


1.3) Which best describes your primary subject area(If you are an educator)? n=161



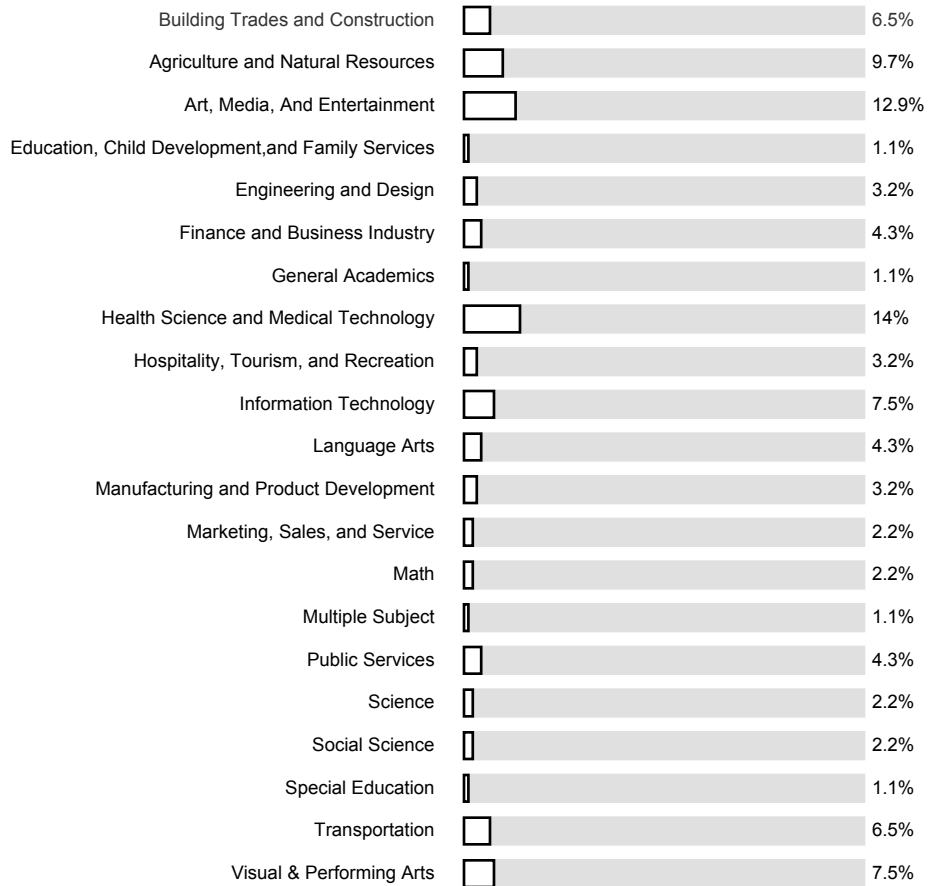
1.4) Which best describes your organization?

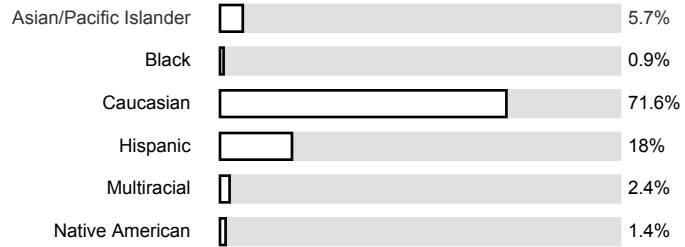
1.5) If you are a teacher, which one of the following best describes your primary subject material?

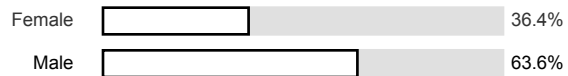

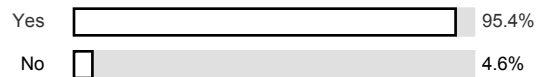

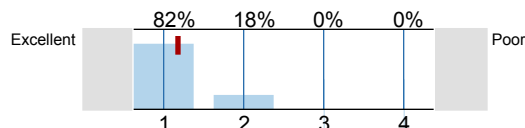


2.2) Is this event valuable enough to be held in the future?

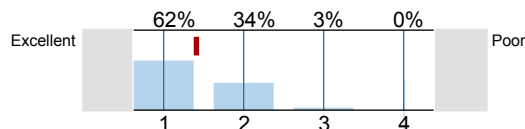

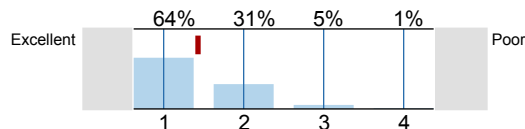

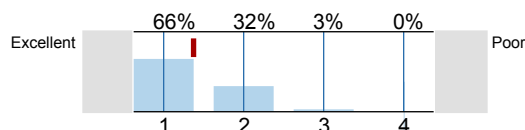
