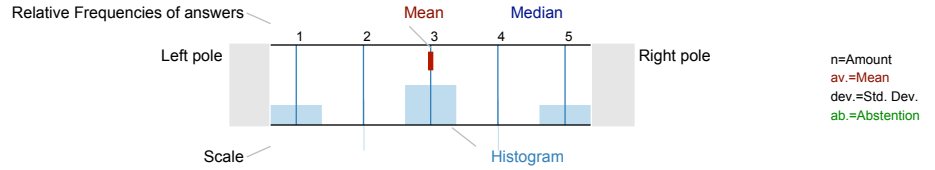

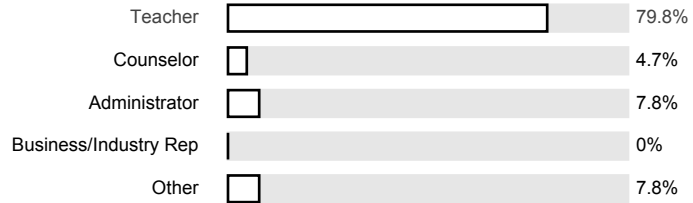

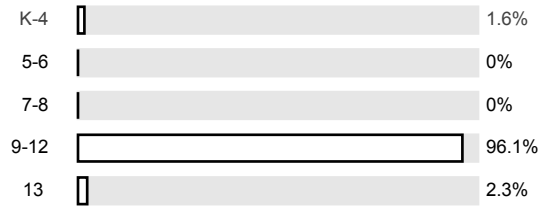
1.1) Which best describes your position?

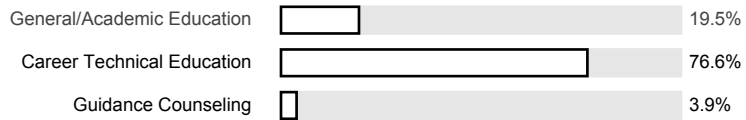
1.2) Which best describes your primary responsibility?

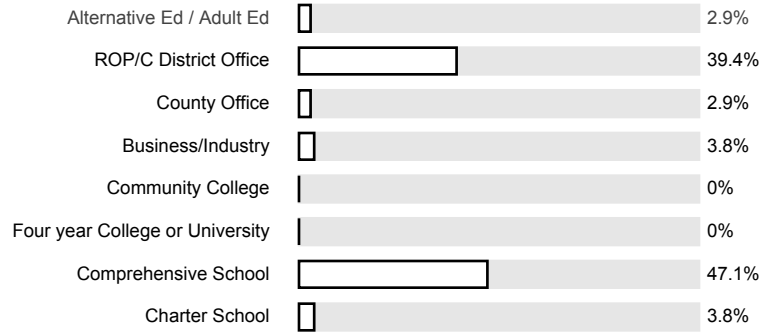
1.3) Which best describes your primary subject area?

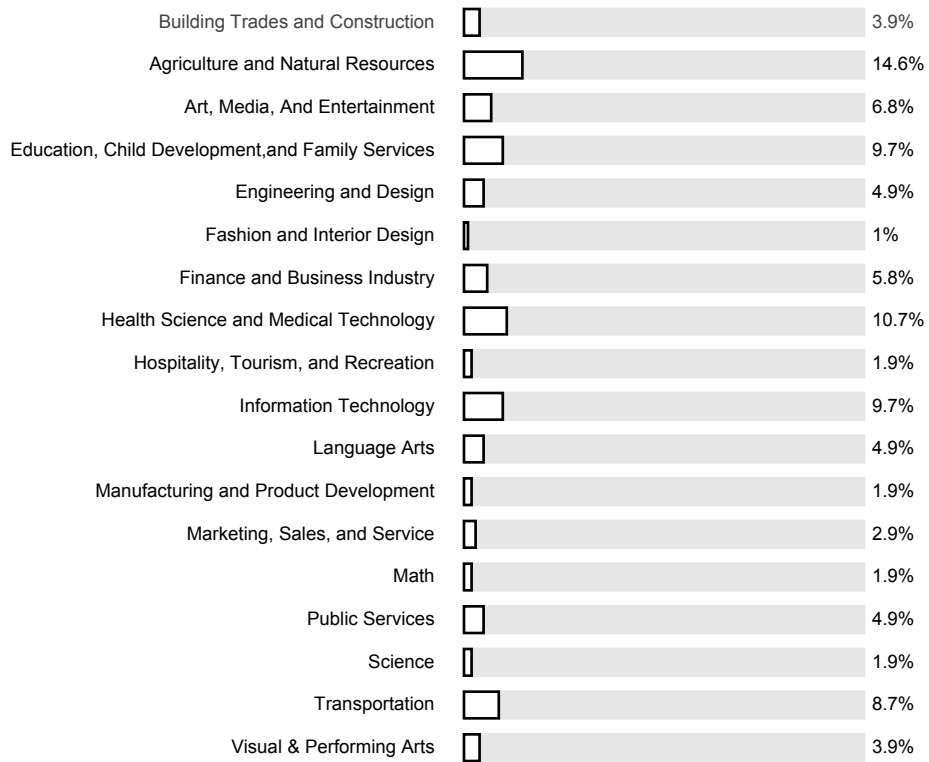
1.4) Which best describes your organization?

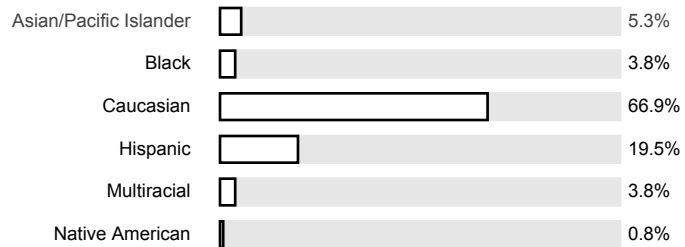
1.5) If you are a teacher, which one of the following best describes your primary subject material?

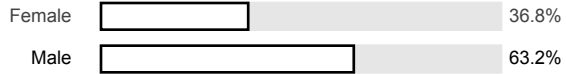

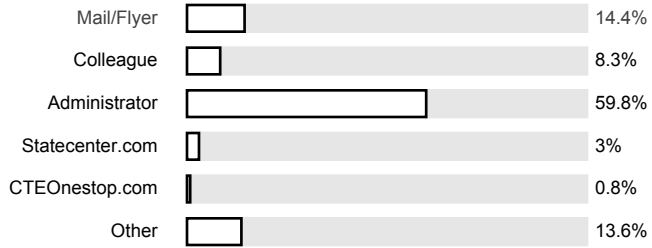

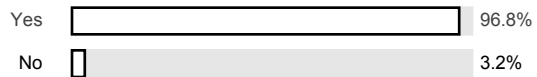
2.1) How did you learn about this workshop?

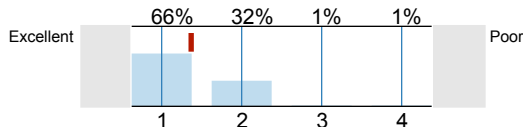


2.2) Did this workshop meet your expectations?

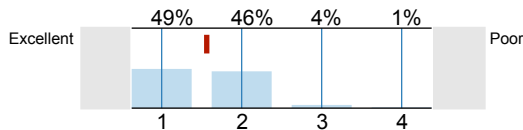


2.3) Amenities and facilities



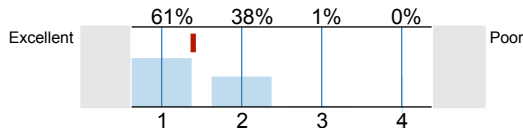

2.4) Overall Evaluation of this workshop



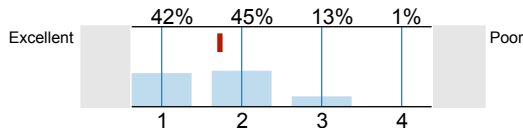

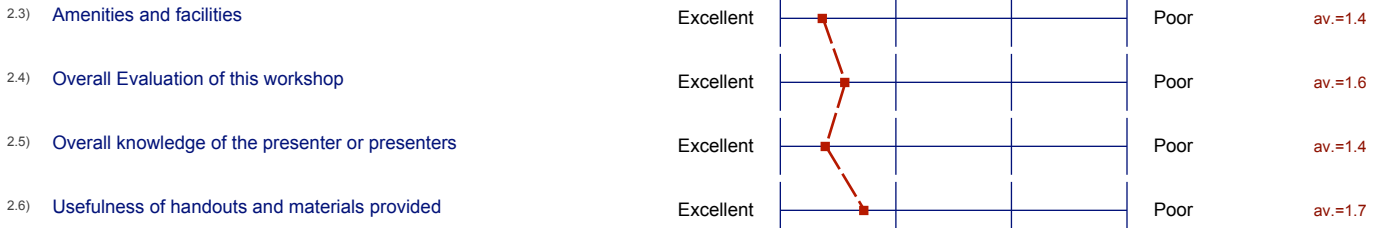
