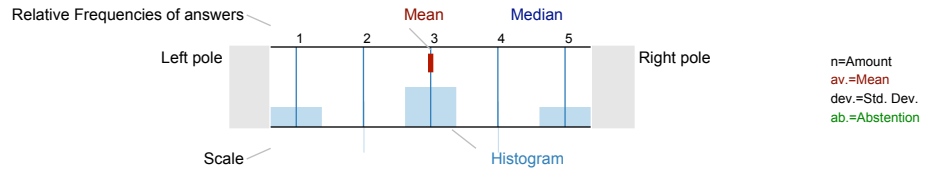

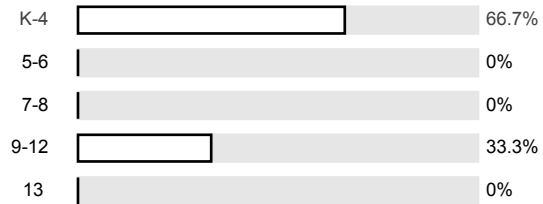

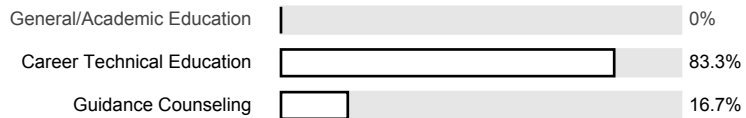
1.2) Which best describes your primary responsibility?

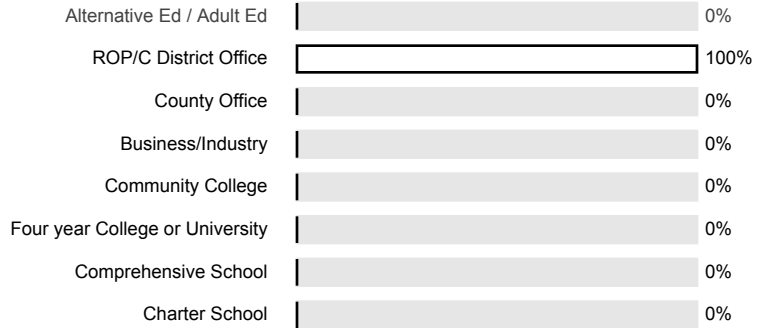
