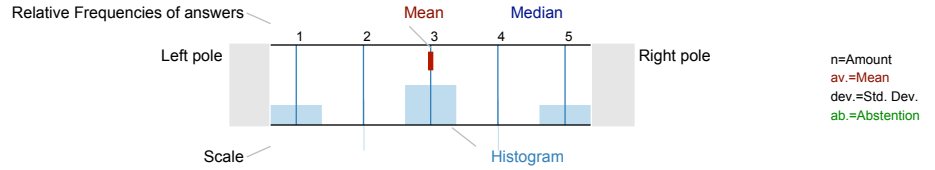

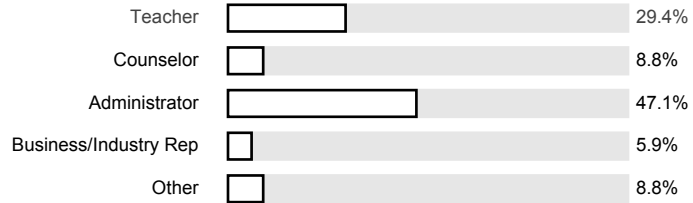

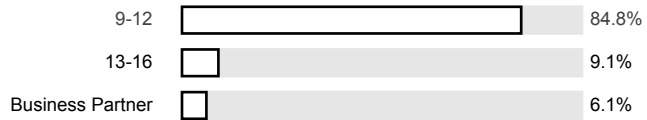
1.1) Which best describes your position?

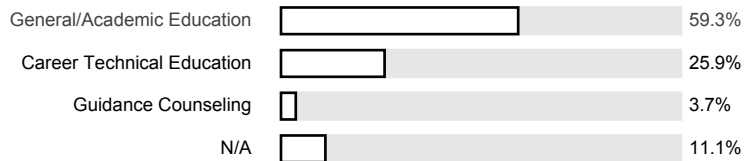
1.2) Which best describes your primary responsibility?

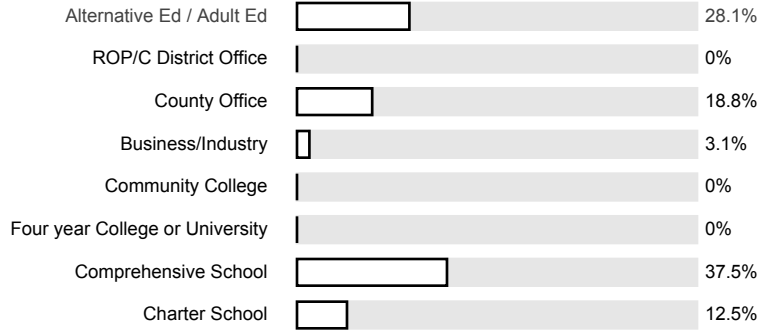
1.3) Which best describes your primary subject area?

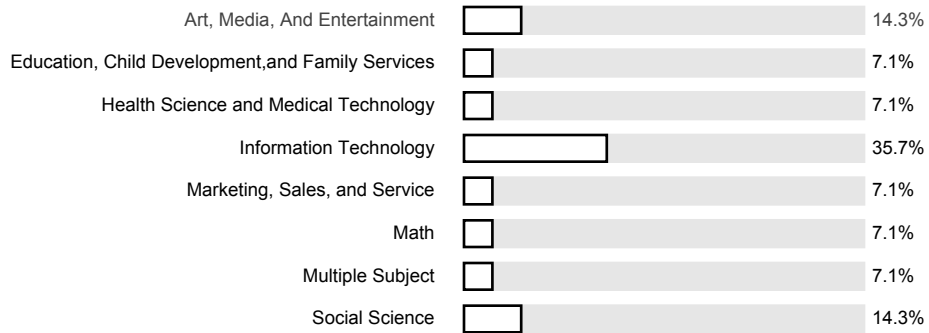
1.4) Which best describes your organization?

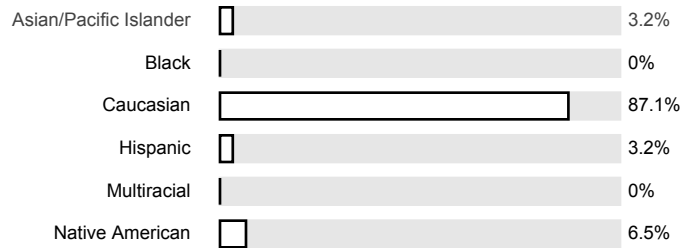

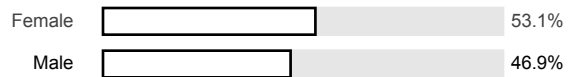

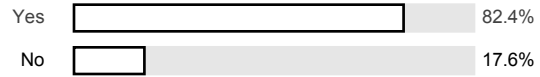

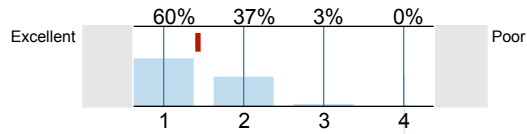

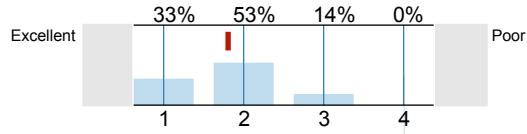

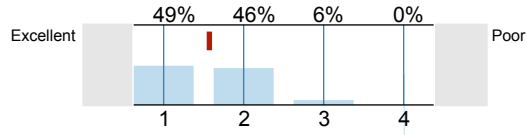

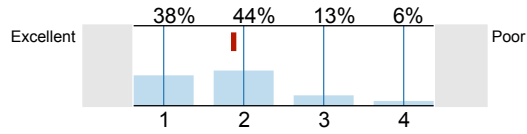
