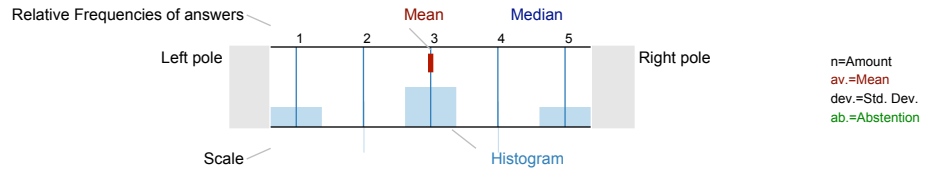

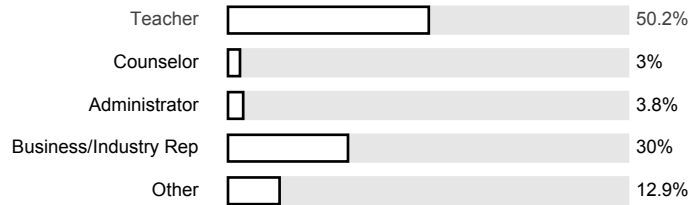

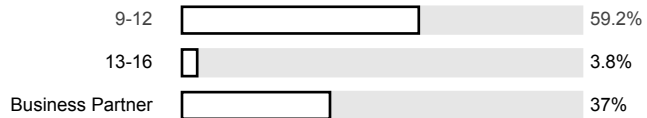

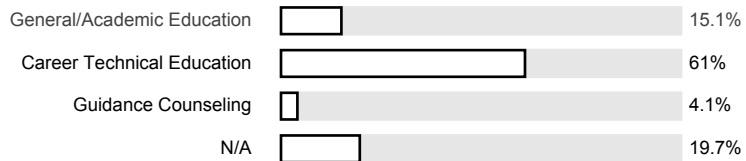
1.1) Which best describes your position? n=263



1.2) Which best describes your primary responsibility? n=238

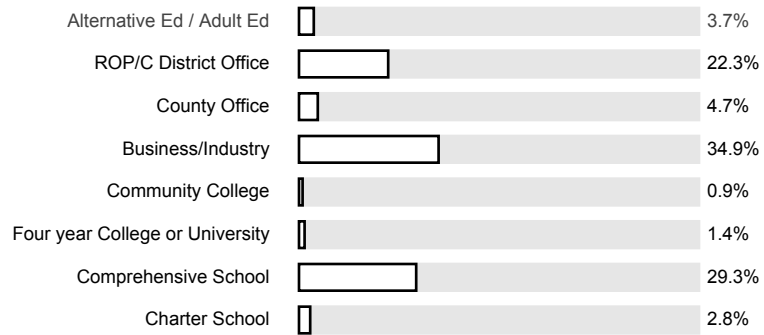


1.3) Which best describes your primary subject area? n=218



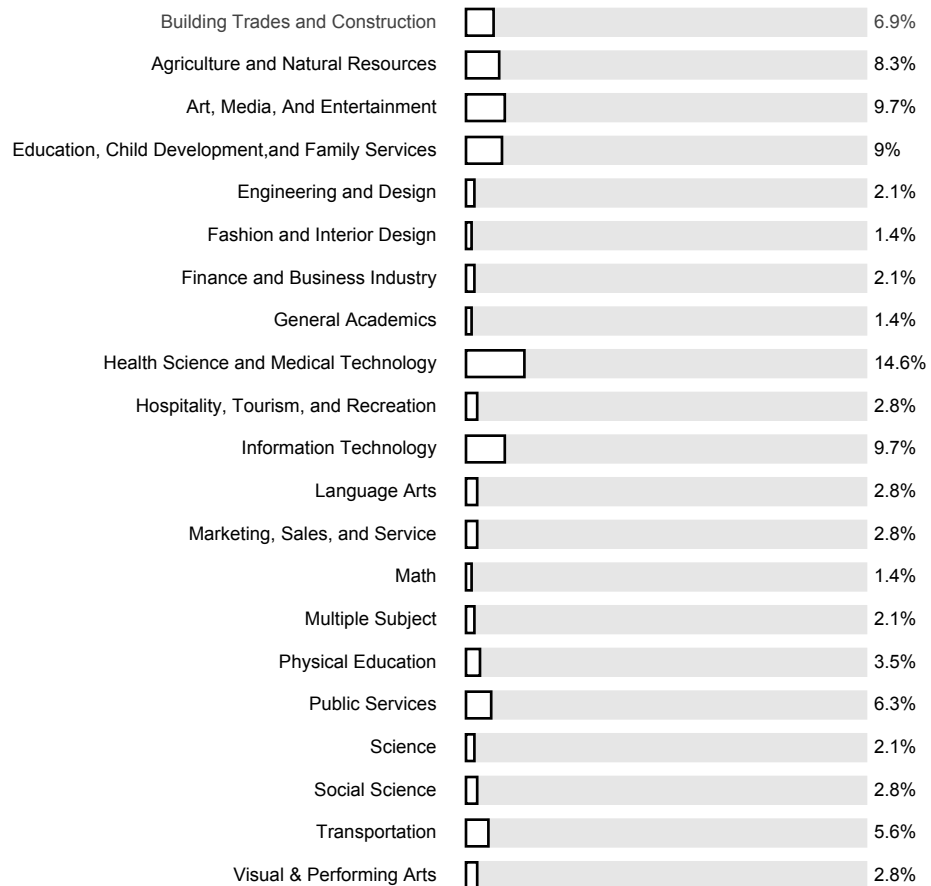
1.4) Which best describes your organization?

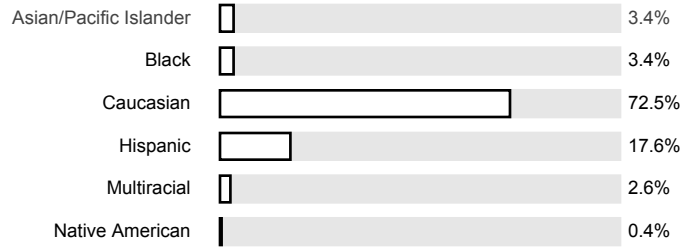

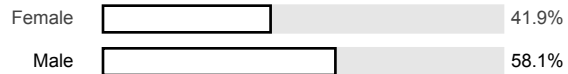

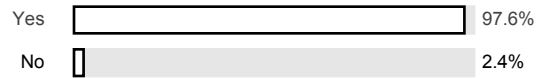

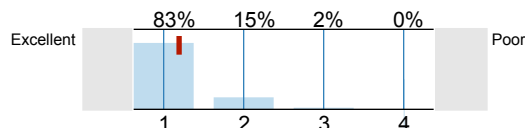

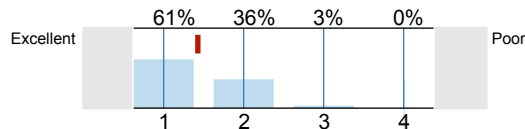

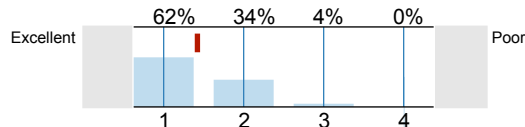
